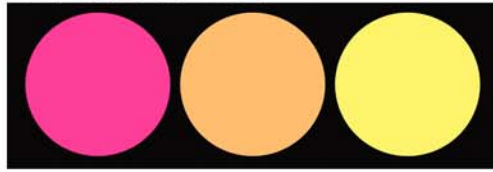

Heirloom Tomatoes

Top 5 Varieties

Cherokee Purple: This tomato has a unique dusty rose color with purplish tint and green shoulders. The extremely sweet, rich smoky taste finishes with a refreshingly perfect acid balance. The seeds of the 100 year old heirloom were first shared by the Cherokee Indians with settlers in what is now Tennessee.



Marvel Stripe: Luscious, extra-large golden tomato with a deep orange marbled interior, this quintessential heirloom variety is named for its radical red stripes and adored for its rich fruity flavor. Originated from Oaxaca Mexico, it is the largest of the bi-colored tomatoes.

Golden Jubilee: An “All American Selection” winner in 1943, this golden orange tomato is a sweet, mild tasting fruit with a non-acid flesh.



Black Crimson (Black Krim): One of the darker varieties, this dark red, maroon tomato originated from the Island of Krim on the Black Sea in Russia. Rich and complex in flavor, it adds a slightly salty taste to its sweetness.

Brandywine: This tomato is the darling of the organic farmer and Farmer’s Markets, reaching sizes up to two pounds. It is meaty with less liquid than its cousin the Beef Steak. With its dark maroon to light red color the intense aroma is followed up by a winy, sweet-tart flavor.
